CARING FOR AND MAINTAINING YOUR CORIAN® SOLID SURFACE

This material was created for a lifetime of easy care. Just follow the simple guidelines listed here to keep your surfaces looking as fresh as the day they were installed.

Start With Common Household Cleaners

For most residues, all you need is warm soapy water or ammonia-based household cleaner. Commercially available solid surface cleaners will also work as well. It is also recommended to occasionally wipe your surface with diluted house bleach.

Keep Your Surfaces Dry

Even though the material is non-porous, film will build up if water is left to dry on the surface. To prevent film build-up, it is very important to wipe the surface completely dry immediately after spills and cleaning. If hard water marks begin to form, use a cleaner formulated for removing hard water marks, such as CLR® or Lime-A-Way®.

Preventing Other Damage

In most cases, these surfaces can be repaired if damaged. For light scratches, a gentle touch with an abrasive pad should do the trick. For deep cuts, it is recommended that you seek professional help before attempting to buff out yourself. Avoid exposing the surface to strong chemicals, such as paint removers, oven cleaners, etc.
